Son Fornés archaeological site was founded at the beginning of the Talayotic period, around 900 BC, and is one of the most important prehistoric settlements in Mallorca. The archeological site has committed to digitalization to promote this cultural asset and is a good example in the frame of the REVIVE project.

11:30 The mountain of the 3 sanctuaries: Nostra Senyora de Cura (Our Lady of Care), Nostra Senyora de Gràcia (Our Lady of Grace) and Sant Honorat.

This mystical mountain is the highest point of Es Pla region and the second most important place for retreats and pilgrimages of the island and is an important cultural asset of the Pla de Mallorca

#### 13.30 Terragust - Agrofarm visit & Lunch

Terragust offers unique gastronomic experiences to discover the local food, how it is grown and when it is harvested. Visitors learn about the crops, taste fruits and vegetables, and enjoy a meal in a countryside environment combining agro and tourism activities. Its products are recognized by the quality seal "Som Pagesos de Mallorca" (Farmers from Mallorca), a certification that distinguishes fresh fruits and vegetables made in the island that meet organic production standards.

The finca dates from 1603 and combines agritourism activity with production of extra virgin olive oil produced from Arbequina olive, a typical variety from the island that has the "Mallorcan olive designation of origin". Finca Treurer has 9 agritourism renovated rooms in a 16<sup>th</sup> century building, offers visitors hospitality in a traditional farming finca and the possibility to learn about the production of extra virgin olive oil.
